GALIMOVA Olga (born 25.08.1990) and GALIMOVA Ludmila (born 28.03.2016) Ubyleynaya Street 12, Flat 131, 14000 Ljubertsy, Moscow, Russia

The "Zurich Center for Fetal Diagnosis and Therapy" (jointly run by the University Hospital Zurich and the University Children's Hospital Zurich) is one of the few centers worldwide to offer open fetal surgery on the unborn child. This highly specialized and innovative technique is mainly used to repair Spina bifida, also called Myelomeningocele. Mrs. Kozlova was diagnosed with a fetus that suffers from Spina bifida (myelomeningocele). Spina bifida is a severe malformation of brain and spinal cord that usually leads to many serious irreversible and lifelong handicaps. The most efficacious therapy today is <u>fetal surgery</u>, i.e. an operation *before* birth. This innovative in utero intervention significantly improves the prognosis for these patients in that the above mentioned handicaps can be avoided or at least be ameliorated markedly. As this in utero treatment is not on offer in Russia, we naturally do also treat patients from Russia.

Mrs. Galimova underwent the open fetal surgery in Zurich in January this year and her daughter Ludmila was born on March 28th 2016.

The following pages show a detailed cost overview for both patients Olga Galimova (mother) and Ludmila Galimova (daughter). Please note the costs are calculated on the basis of our Swiss DRG-System (Diagnosis-Related-Groups). This DRG-System produces a cost weight for an individual condition and the cost weight is then multiplied by the hospital specific base rate and this finally produces total costs. Therefore it is difficult to give a precise breakdown of costs.
